



Visit the famous Scandola nature reserve and the cosy fishing village of Girolata

We will go with a boat from Calvi and follow the coastline south to the natural reserve of Scandola. Gradually the coast changes into red granite cliffs that plunge into the sea. Classified as a world heritage site by UNESCO, this natural reserve is an ecological paradise with exceptional flora and fauna. The reserve was created in 1975 and is only accessible by boat.

Close to the nature reserve, we will stop the boat for a break. Here you can swim in the crystal clear water and watch over the astonishing cliffs while you will receive a refreshing aperitif of Corsican wine. What better way is there to experience the Scandola nature reserve?

After visiting the reserve we continue to Girolata, a small fishing hamlet just outside Scandola. Here you can enjoy lunch at one of the several restaurants, walk along the coastline or just take a break on the beach.
