



Get a taste of Corsica as you explore villages of the Balagne region and try some of its local delicacies

A roundtrip among the small villages of the Balagne region. "Route des Artisans de Balagne" is a sign-posted trail that shows the region's most attractive villages and local workshops. We have picked what we think is the best!

We start in the village of Calenzana with a visit to Christian at "E Fritelle". Here we get the opportunity to taste classic Corsican biscuits. Next stop is Lunghignano where we learn about local olive oil. We try it and get a chance to buy some. If we are lucky, we may see the donkeys who plays a big part in creating the olive oil... After a winding road with beautiful views we reach St Antonino and taste some refreshing lemon juice. We also have time to explore the small hill top village with breathtaking views over the bay and the sea.

Last stop is Pigna. Famous for the many artists that have small workshops in the village. Here we will enjoy a three course meal and delicious local wine. Afterwards you have time to stroll around the village before we return to the hotel.
