

Get a taste of Corsica as you explore villages of the Balagne region and taste some local delicacies

A roundtrip through the small villages of the Balagne region, the "Route des Artisans de Balagne" is a sign-posted trail that shows the region's most attractive villages and local workshops. We have picked what we think is the best!

We start in the village of Calenzana with a visit to Christian at "E Fritelle". Here we get the opportun ity to taste classic Corsican biscuits. Next stop is Lunghignano where we learn about local olive oil, taste it, and have a chance to buy some. After a winding road with beautiful views we reach St Antonino and taste some refreshing lemon juice. We also have some time to explore the small hill top village with breath-taking views over the bay and the sea.

Last stop is Pigna. Famous for the many artists that have small workshops in the village. Here we will enjoy a three course meal and delicious local wine. Afterwards you have time to stroll around the village before we return to the hotel.
